Precinct Boundaries and Polling Locations are Changing!

Hernando County Supervisor of Elections Shirley Anderson went before the Board of County Commissioners on Tuesday, August 26, 2022, for approval of the proposed new precinct boundaries. Every ten years following the census the state legislators redraw congressional boundaries as well as state house and state senate. This process was completed on April 22, 2022, with the final map being passed. The Board of County Commissioners redrew their lines in 2021 per Florida Statute 124.01 (3). The School District did not pass new maps.

The elections office then took census data and other information such as voter turnout, vote-by-mail requests, and redrew the precinct boundaries.

The Board of County Commissioners voted unanimously to approve the new precinct boundaries presented by Supervisor Anderson. Hernando County will have 32 precincts voting at 29 polling locations. Maps can be found at <https://www.hernandovotes.gov/Resources/Maps>

“Redistricting is a complicated process, but it allows us the opportunity to adjust for growth and find the best facilities available for voters. All voters will be mailed a new Voter Information Card in June informing them of their polling location. In addition, a voter can always use our Voter Lookup Tool to look themselves up prior to going to vote,” stated Supervisor Anderson.

To avoid confusion on Election Day, make sure to:

- Review your new Voter Information Card when it arrives in June.
- Use the Voter Lookup Tool prior to voting to get directions to your polling location.
- Call the elections office at 352.754.4125 for questions.
