All Vote-by-Mail Ballot Requests Expired in 2022 Sign Up Now for 2024 Election Cycle

Due to state legislative changes, Vote-by-Mail requests now expire after each General Election. If you would like to vote by mail in the 2024 election cycle, you must submit a new Vote-by-Mail request.

New requests can be submitted through the website (<u>www.HernandoVotes.gov</u>) or by calling the Supervisor of Elections office at 352-754-4125. Written requests are also accepted; however, all requests must include the voter's date of birth, Florida driver's license number/Florida ID and/or last four digits of SSN, signature, and their Hernando County residence address.

Vote-by-Mail ballots are considered non-forwardable mail, so make sure your address is up to date with the Elections Office. If the ballot is to be mailed to an address other than what is on file, then we must have the voter's signature and the address of where the ballot should be sent.

Do not request a Vote-by-Mail ballot to be used as a sample ballot. A sample ballot will be mailed to you. One request is all that is needed -do not send duplicate requests.
